




### Were you aware that new PREA regulations became effective in August 2012?



Does your agency have an MOU with any of the following to provide advocacy services with




#### General advocacy- over the phone (i.e.crisis intervention, safety planning)




# General Advocacy via written correspondence




# General advocacy- in person at a correctional facility





Does your agency collaborate with any facilities to provide education to staff and/or inmates about sexual assault?










Should advocacy services for incarcerated individuals be prioritized along with community advocacy services?




How would you prioritize providing advoca	C






Do you anticipate that your agency's advocates will have or have already experienced a conflict with providing services to incarcerated individuals?
