Position Summary

The Communications Intern will work closely with the Training and Communications Director to facilitate communications, in print and digital media, that is engaging and informational while promoting the activities of the agency and staff. The ideal candidate is creative and social media-savvy with a genuine concern about sexual violence and a passion to make a difference. This candidate will have a willingness to deepen their analysis of social justice and be genuinely concerned about sexual violence with a passion to make a difference. Knowledge of basic graphic design principles and multimedia tools a plus. We request a minimum commitment of 15 hours a week, with up to 25 hours a week available. Scheduling is flexible.

Major Responsibilities

Assist with the development of internal and external communications products such as factsheets, newsletters, social media and website content, blog posts, etc. Working on specific projects as assigned, such as; support for creation of a communications plan/strategy for Sexual Assault Awareness Month (SAAM), design advertisement of the Training Institute, among others. Support with other tasks as needed.
